THIS PERMIT ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1. This permit grants to the volunteer those rights specifically stated and no other.
- 2. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the volunteer from meeting any and all requirements with other public bodies or agencies.
- 3. The volunteer shall save harmless Skagit County Government and all officers, and agents thereof, against any and all claims arising from operations covered by this permit.
- 4. Assignments will be made on a first come basis. Group must agree to pickup litter a minimum of (4) times a year, during designated dates in April, June, August & October.
- 5. All work days are to be scheduled with appropriate Skagit County Parks and Recreation (SCPR) staff to insure availability of needed safety equipment and the availability of needed resources.
- 6. This permit expires after 2 years. Groups may renew the permit.
- 7. The applicant must have enough people power to conduct the necessary duties to adopt the trail or park. Crew leader and group contact person(s) must be identified above. Organization must be based in Skagit County.
- 8. Volunteer groups shall consist of at least (1) person who is 18 years of age or older.
- 9. Participants must hold a safety meeting once a year prior to the first pickup, conducted by the adopting group with provided safety tips used as a guideline.
- 10. All trash must be placed in bags. Those objects too large/heavy shall be placed next to the bags. Full bags are to be placed in designated locations for pickup. No personal household trash of group members will be accepted.
- 11. The SCPR Department will supply the initial set of signs recognizing your group's participation in the program. Any signs which are stolen, damaged, defaced or destroyed may be replaced at the group's expense.
- 12. The SCPR Department shall retain the right to revoke any permit at any time. The volunteer group, upon request of the SCPR Department, shall immediately cease operations and surrender this permit. Issuance of a permit and/or participation in the ADOPT-A-TRAIL OR PARK program does not indicate SCPR supports or endorses any organization or position.
